

INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA intended for Customers/Suppliers pursuant to art. 13 EU Regulation 2016/679

For the purposes set out in EU Regulation 2016/679 (hereinafter Regulation or GDPR) relating to the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data, we inform you that the processing of personal data provided by you and acquired by Gamma Chimica SpA (hereinafter Gamma Chimica), will be processed in compliance with the legislation set out in the aforementioned Regulation in compliance with the consequent rights and obligations.

Data Controller

Types of data processed

Chemical Range processes common identification data and complete company personal data that are granted to the company in order to provide the requested service in accordance with current legislation.

Data recipients:

The personal data relating to the processing in question will be communicated, if this is necessary or in any case functional to the management of the contractual relationship and the pursuit of the legitimate interest of the owner, to the following subjects:

- subjects designated for data processing by the owner regularly appointed pursuant to articles 29 and 32 of the GDPR;
- to banking, credit and/or financial institutions for the completion of payments;
- to private entities and professional firms responsible for handling matters relating to the employment relationship (e.g. accountant) regularly appointed pursuant to art. 28 of the GDPR;
- any law firms for the resolution of contracts and/or disputes;
- customs agency, where necessary;
- suppliers, hardware and software support technicians, who carry out outsourcing activities;
- Authorities, Public Administrations and Supervisory and Control Bodies for their institutional purposes;
- may be made available to third parties for the defense of rights, as well as in compliance with the obligations established by law or regulations and upon request by the competent authorities.

Data transfer

The data collected will be used by Gamma Chimica for the complete and correct execution of the contract; to carry out this treatment it is not necessary to acquire the company's consent.

Any refusal to provide such data will result in Gamma Chimica not being able to provide the requested service to the extent that the data is necessary for the same.

Data retention periods

The data will be retained for the entire duration of the contract. At the end of this period, the company will archive all data for a period of ten years, as required by current legislation, while the cancellation, where applicable, will be carried out on data that have exceeded twelve years of archiving. Gamma Chimica has a specific Data Retention Policy .

Treatment methods

The processing is carried out by the owner and by the subjects designated and expressly trained in the management of data processing; each processing of personal data takes place in compliance with the principles set out in art. 5 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679. The data processing is carried out with the following methods and security precautions:

- the security of data processed on computer media is managed through a password system;
- Gamma Chimica has drawn up a Policy for the planning and management of company “back-ups”;
- the confidentiality of paper documentation is guaranteed by the storage of documents in special archives with controlled and authorised access only to designated subjects;
- the accuracy of the recorded data is checked annually.

Gamma Chimica does not transfer to third countries; it does not have an automated decision-making process relating to natural persons and does not perform profiling. The data may be transferred to countries within the EU and outside the EU; such transfers may be carried out by Entities and/or companies receiving the data as specified above under “data recipients”.

RIGHTS OF INTERESTED PARTIES

In order to fulfill the obligations set forth in the Regulation in question, Gamma Chimica reminds you of the applicable rights of interested parties.

The interested party has the right to request confirmation of whether or not personal data concerning him or her are being processed.

The interested party has the right to obtain:

- the indications regarding the purposes of the processing, the categories of personal data, the recipients or categories of recipients to whom the personal data have been or will be communicated and, where possible, the retention period;
- the rectification and deletion of data;
- the limitation of processing.

The data subject shall have the right to receive the personal data concerning him or her, which he or she has provided to a controller, in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format and shall have the right to transmit those data to another controller without hindrance from the controller to which the personal data have been provided.

Pursuant to art. 77 the interested party has the right to:

How to exercise your rights

Gamma Chimica has created a specific email address to allow interested parties to easily exercise their rights: privacy@gammachimica.it.

Upon receipt of the request to exercise the rights, the privacy representative will contact the company DPO who will take care of satisfying the interested party's request. If it is not possible for the interested party to send this request via email, it can be sent by ordinary mail via registered mail to the company's registered office : Gamma Chimica SpA via Lepetit 8, 20045 Lainate (MI).

The exercise of the rights by the user is free of charge pursuant to art. 12 GDPR. However, in the case of manifestly unfounded or excessive requests, also due to their repetitiveness, the owner may charge the user a reasonable fee, in light of the administrative costs incurred to manage his request, or deny the satisfaction of his request .
