

INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA of the Newsletter service pursuant to art. 13 EU Regulation 2016/679

The newsletter is a service that allows the user to stay updated on the initiatives of Gamma Chimica SpA (hereinafter Gamma Chimica) by receiving communications on its activities.

It is sent by email to companies and those who explicitly request it and/or customers who have used the services of Gamma Chimica . For the purposes set out in EU Regulation 2016/679 (hereinafter Regulation or GDPR) relating to the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data , with this information Gamma Chimica wishes to inform all users registered for the service that the personal data provided by you will be processed in compliance with the legislation set out in the aforementioned Regulation in compliance with the resulting rights and obligations.

Data Controller

The data controller is Gamma Chimica SpA ; the data protection officer (DPO) is Dr. Giuliana Dolci who can be contacted at the email address : privacy@gammachimica.it.

The sending of newsletters has a retention period of 1 year starting from the last communication for which there is evidence of direct interaction (click, opening, response).

After the above-mentioned retention periods have elapsed, the data will be deleted or made anonymous, from all archives with the technical deletion procedures, including from the backups performed.

Cancellation from service

To stop receiving newsletters from Gamma Chimica, you can deactivate the service by clicking on the appropriate link at the bottom of each newsletter. The user will be automatically redirected to a specific cancellation confirmation link.

Types of data processed

The data is communicated spontaneously by the user. The optional, explicit and voluntary sending of messages to the contact addresses of Gamma Chimica, the compilation and forwarding of the forms on the site, involve the acquisition of the sender's contact data, necessary to respond, as well as all personal data included in the communications.

Data recipients

Your data may be shared with third parties/entities and, pursuant to art. 28 of the Regulation, appointed as external data controllers. Such parties/entities are: designated parties who act on the basis of specific instructions provided by the data controller to process personal data and who have undertaken to maintain confidentiality or have an adequate legal obligation of confidentiality;

- subjects delegated and/or appointed by the owner to carry out activities strictly related to the pursuit of the purposes indicated above (including technical maintenance interventions on the systems), duly appointed as data controllers;
- subjects, entities or authorities to whom the communication of your personal data is mandatory by virtue of provisions of law or orders of the competent authorities.

Gamma Chimica does not transfer to third countries; it does not have an automated decision-making process relating to natural persons and does not perform profiling. The data could be transferred to countries within the EU and outside the EU; such transfers could be carried out by entities and/or companies receiving the data as specified above under “[data recipients](#)”.

Treatment methods

The processing is carried out by the owner and by the subjects designated and expressly trained in the management of data processing; each processing of personal data takes place in compliance with the principles set out in art. 5 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679. The data processing is carried out with the following methods and security precautions:

- the security of data processed on computer media is managed through a password system;
- Gamma Chimica has drawn up a Data Retention Policy for the planning and management of company “back-ups”;
- the confidentiality of paper documentation is guaranteed by the storage of documents in special archives with controlled and authorised access only to designated subjects;
- the accuracy of the recorded data is checked annually.

RIGHTS OF INTERESTED PARTIES

In order to fulfill the obligations set forth in the Regulation in question, Gamma Chimica reminds you of the applicable rights of interested parties.

The interested party has the right to request confirmation of whether or not personal data concerning him or her are being processed.

The interested party has the right to obtain:

- the indications regarding the purposes of the processing, the categories of personal data, the recipients or categories of recipients to whom the personal data have been or will be communicated and, where possible, the retention period;
- the rectification and deletion of data.

The interested party has the right to:

- object to the processing at any time and also in the case of processing for direct marketing purposes;
- object to automated individual decision-making, including profiling;
- to withdraw consent at any time without prejudice to the lawfulness of the processing based on the consent given before the withdrawal.

Pursuant to art. 77 the interested party has the right to:

How to exercise your rights

Gamma Chimica has created a specific email address to allow interested parties to easily exercise their rights: privacy@gammachimica.it.

Upon receipt of the request to exercise the rights, the privacy representative will contact the company DPO who will take care of satisfying the interested party's request. If it is not possible for the interested party to send this request via email, it can be sent by ordinary mail via registered mail to the company's registered office : Gamma Chimica SpA via Lepetit 8, 20045 Lainate (MI).

The exercise of the rights by the user is free of charge pursuant to art. 12 GDPR. However, in the case of manifestly unfounded or excessive requests, also due to their repetitiveness, the owner may charge the user a reasonable fee, in light of the administrative costs incurred to manage his request, or deny the satisfaction of his request.
